See the beautiful landscape of Giles County, Virginia, through the eyes of the county's young artists during the new exhibition, *Young Artists: Home*.

With help from Giles County Public Schools art teacher Amber Nelson, area artists, and community organizations, Moss Arts Center Exhibition Program Manager Meggin Hicklin offered a series of workshops, called "art breaks," for students in fourth through seventh grades. Workshops were held over the course of three weeks at each of the county's three elementary/middle schools—Eastern, Macy McClaugherty, and Narrows—both during and after school hours. The purpose was for students to unleash their creativity and capture the stunning landscapes of Giles County using a variety of techniques. Students participated in workshops, including work in photography, making sculptures from materials gathered from the land, painting, and drawing. The final projects from the workshops will be featured in the exhibition.

*Home* will be on view at the Moss Arts Center through July 3.
