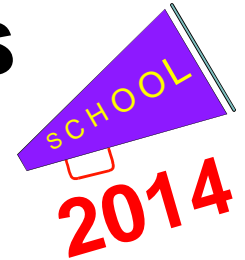




# FREE Summer Food Programs in Giles County!

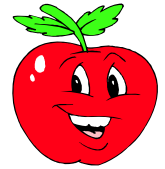

### RULES AND REGULATIONS

By attending our program, participants agree to each of the following terms:

- \* Participants are younger than age 19.
- \* Participants do not have any food allergies which meet the ADA guidelines.
- \* Participants must take 3 items for breakfast & 4 items for lunch (offer vs. serve).
- \* Participants must adhere to all school rules.
- \* Any disciplinary action may result in termination of eligibility.
- \* Participants are not to leave the cafeteria and bathroom hallway areas unless receiving prior authorization from administration.
- \* Adults (age 19+) may buy a tray with all menu'd items for \$2. Ala carte items are available for additional costs.
- \* Carry-out trays are available for adults only (cost is \$3 for the menu'd tray or if purchasing ala carte items there will be additional charges).
- \* Parents/guardians are encouraged to remain with their children during meal times.
- \* Giles County Public Schools will not be responsible for children while on site.
- \* Please dispose of your tray and trash in the appropriate receptacles.
