PUBLIC COMMENTS

Melissa Weddle, secretary at Giles High School, attended the meeting to address the problem of the substitute shortage in the county. She distributed some substitute data from Giles High School. She stated that we do not have enough active subs. She has done some research for pay in surrounding counties and stated that we are all pretty close in pay. She stated that we could advertise for substitutes in the Virginian Leader and on social media. Another suggestion is to offer a tiered pay scale and do have a minimum requirement of so many days to stay on the substitute list. She also stated that hiring floating substitutes at the schools would be nice.

Sonva Meekins attended on behalf of the Giles Education Association. She stated that they have decided to actively participate in an active campaign with the BOS to pursue salary increases. They will be working with them monthly, starting tonight. In August, they plan to start town hall meetings - and do community outreach with educational partners - recommend a meals tax, increase personal property taxes, etc. The goal is to get a 12% pay increase. She thanked the board for all they have done. She stated that the bottom line is that we are losing teachers and it is hitting across the country.

- C. The School Board, on motion of Mr. Wilburn, with second by Mr. Pennington and unanimous voting, approved the Chairman and Superintendent to accept RFP's and offer employment between School Board Meetings, if needed. The School Board Chairman and Superintendent, in some cases, need to authorize employment, resignation and RFP's. The Board is requested to continue this practice. All such actions are brought before the full Board for confirmation/action.
- D. The School Board, on motion of Mr. Wilburn, with second by Mr. Pennington and unanimous voting, approved Mr. Rick Franklin to sign documents in the Superintendent's absence, for the 18-19 school year. The VA Dept. of Education requests that the School Board appoint designee(s) to sign documents in the event the Superintendent is unavailable when his signature is needed.
- E. The School Board, on motion of Mr. Steele, with second by Mrs. Guynn and unanimous voting, approved an increase in student and adult meal prices by \$.05.
- F. The School Board, on motion of Mrs. Guynn, with second by Mr. Wilburn and unanimous voting, approved textbook adoptions as recommended by Mrs. Tibbs.

Mr. Ballard discussed the proposed compensation committee. Dr. Arbogast stated that he is not sure what this will look like, but assumes the intent is to try to explain where we are with state budge/revenue and where we would like to be with salaries. He's not sure at this time who will make up this committee. On motion of Mr. Ballard, with second by Mr. Wilburn and unanimous voting, the board made a motion to send two representatives to the compensation committee.

The School Board discussed the shared services contract. Mr. Ballard has let Mr. McKlarney know we would like to have our custodians back on the school system side. The School Board, on motion of Mr. Ballard, with second by Mr. Wilburn and unanimous voting, moved that the School Board does not wish to renew the Shared Services Contract with the Giles County Board of Supervisors as written. We request that all custodian employees be returned to the School Board for contractual purposes. The board wishes to have full oversight over these employees. We would like to retain all other aspects of the contract and work with the county on any additions, deletions or modifications in wording as needed. Mr. Steele had a concern that we may have to end up spending more to maintain our buildings the way they need to be. Dr. Arbogast stated that we originally transferred over 17 and now it looks like we would have 15 coming back from the county.

The School Board discussed the RFP for the Facilities Assessment. They decided to discuss this at the next work session. Mr. Steele stated that he

knows people will be upset if they hear about spending money on an assessment, but stated that the buildings have now almost fully appreciated again. The county is asking what we will need fixed. The company would come in and look at our buildings from top to bottom. Mr. Ballard stated that the request for proposal does not mean that we are going to go out and spend \$100K, but the company is going to come back with a bid to see how much it will cost to look over all of the buildings. He stated that it is our responsibility as a board to keep up with our buildings. Mrs. Guynn stated that she is not for taking anything away from our teachers because we need buses, teachers need raises, aides, etc. She stated that when something breaks down, we get it fixed.

- Dr. Arbogast stated that our enrollment as of today, without preschool, is 2372.
- Dr. Arbogast congratulated the engineering and technology design team at the Tech Center for winning first place at the State SkillsUSA competition. The team consists of Dayton Brown, Gretchen Carr and Landon Porterfield. Good luck as they move forward.
- Dr. Arbogast stated that last week was National School Nutrition Employee week. No Kids Hungry sent a letter to him to recognize Christy Lawson as a school nutrition hero.
- Dr. Arbogast stated that Rappahanock County is coming to visit the Ag Land Lab on June 4th.
- Dr. Arbogast asked for approval of a new Grade 12 Mathematics Capstone Course for Narrows High School. They would use current staff. The School Board, on motion of Mr. Wilburn, with second by Mr. Pennington and unanimous voting, approved the new course.
- Dr. Arbogast congratulated the NEMS elementary archery team. They qualified for world championships in Louisville Kentucky from June 8 10.
- Dr. Arbogast informed board members that Rhonda Tickle will be retiring effective June 2nd.
- Dr. Arbogast discussed the school shield equipment grant. The grant was submitted and we received notification that our application was recommended for funding. We don't know how much we will get at this time.
- Dr. Arbogast stated that some SOL results are coming in so far things coming back look promising.
- Mrs. Guynn commended the STEMposium. It was very rewarding!
- Mrs. Guynn congratulated all the Teachers of the Year!
- Mrs. Guynn thanked all the teachers she knows it's a very stressful time with SOL testing.
- Mrs. Guynn commended Cole Meadows for signing for Concord College, Josh Weddle for signing to Notre Dame, Noah Clark for Concord College and Maddie Vangelos for scoring her 100th career goal.
- Mr. Wilburn also commended the STEMposium at GHS.
